Childrens rights to being treated appropriately, and not being subjected to abuse, contributer to their well-being, as they do not experience abuse that uill impact upon their state of mind and well-being. Shuse may lead to them experienceing low self estern, lack of necessary needs and they may lose their sense of Identity. Both Education and being treated



appropriately are important contributants to exitations, well-being of a child.

Their our experience will also infuence the way they view adoption and their perception of the family. * The Gender of the parent or carer is another factor which will influence relationships. Each individual percieves their gender and gender expectations in a different way and uill therefore allow their gender & gender expectations to infuence their relationships in accordance with their views. * Socio-economic status is the financial status of an Individual or Samily. To adopt a child a large amount of money is involved, and the parents must be financially stable. The Socio economic status of a family influences parenting and caring relationships on this family situation, as money and stability is the only way in which to adopt a child. * Health will impact upon relationships, parenting



and caring. Adaptive parents are required to be healthy enough to raise a child.
