Wellbring connot be active acheived without these essentials, so the stage the fulfilment of his right is an important one for well-bing. Having someone to love and for care for a child is also important. This sense of love will atom increase well being in children because it makes then feel good about thenselves. b) dildcare services come in many forms, and are injurtant for supporting parents or covers in the role of looking offer children. Child care services can include long day care - after school care - playgroups. these all contribute support poverts and caves los providing the aportonity for then to work while their children are safety cared for or by giving them a break as they complete other roles that are necessary. play groups are an important service that supports poorts and covers, and they perform many roles, not just the main one of having a child looked after for a period of fine. playgroups can be a very setil service to he poverts, as they can need other poverts while at the group. This can be an opportunity to not new people with the same neds and wants as you and sale of the same age. This



can improve a parents well being as they swap knowledge about childcare, compare peventing Styles and fechniques and feel good about Heir own children. These services are often government supported, and can be provided with finding, equipment and training so the group can function. This is one reason why this service can be so uzeful. Often pavents with not have the resources to buy or se & all the exipment for a childs care of extendent or wellbeing. Bing a playgroup, here things are provided. Its function of giving the pavents and cares a moch needed break from looking after this children is an important one. Parents need time out" & so they can relax, and let someone else look after their children this will improve the pavents well being. and lastly, the child is kept happy and entertained, as they get to play with other



children and experience the excitement of learning though play and interaction with other Mildre. This is important for parents, as the child will the probably be legot happy if they are able to se a playgray. for all these reasons, playgroups are very effective in supporting programment hose who have roles of parents or cavers. c) the fostering is a form of social paventing where a child is looked after and supported for either short or long periods of time. Often these children are from parents who have divorced and cannot provide the care needed, or from parents who have addictions, disabilities or other social problems Such as donestic violence. The department of community services manages the fostering of children, their support and the possibility of them returning to their paverts. There are vary issues with fostering that will affect the paventing situation. these are: - long term effects from above



- short term care and the effects of constantly Moving - child's needs and wants - The dild may prefer to get up with above or lack of care so they can stay with their real parents - issue of favourites foster pavents may give more love and care to their biological thildren. The reasons for testering nontroned previously play a large role in how the paventing situation will be affected as in the faster homes. A A dild ca be difficult to marage for a number of reasons. They may be feeling guilt because a divorce or fley May be insecure because of a abusive relationship in the past. TUST is a inportant issue. The faster pavents need to build up a trusting relationship or the dild will never accept them. The issue of favouritism is important. dildren as Giological children. factors influencing the relationship does not just include the factors from old relationships and favoritism issues. financial situation of foster poverts, exployment and access to resources all influences this as well. for triately, there are support payments that can be received.
