

This technique is also used earlier in his speech when licero voices what may be the concerns of the & cenators to at the appearance of a novice as the depender. Here the questions to are used to good effect as in each one, he makes mustion ob more qualities so particularly detestable to the Romans & severtous, such as 'andas' & Tuxundes. However, while he mentions these Cicero dismisses any possible link of mese with his altent.
