b) A social definition of a homeless person is those people without access to see adequate housing. A legal definition is those people without access to a permanent, safe home environment. Health - This is a very difficult need to meet without access to a permanent, safe home experiment. Homeless people usually have a low mome which makes it difficult to purchase medication. Also, hygiere is difficult to maintain with the inability to wash and dean prequently due to a lack of bathroom. Pour hygicne leads to poor health. Howeless people have difficulty obtaining a health card or medicare card as they have no permanent address They While there are some initiatives to assist homeless people to remain healthy, such as NSW Health sending nuses out on the streets, there is a lack of health services for the type of care homeless people need. Homeless people suffer from

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back of sleep and depression due to a lack of self-esteen. Homeless people are also ofter substance abusers as a result of their depression. They have poor types diets & their outritional needs are not met. Financial support - Hunders people have low income and finances, which is often the reason why they are homeless. It is difficult to obtain employment for homeless people when they don't have a permenent address or access to a shower. It is also difficult for homeless people to receive controllike payments as they have no address to send it to These people need prancial support in order to get them out of the vicious cycle of homelessness. They also often waste income on substance abuse due to depression. Serve of Identity - Homeless people prod it difficult to achieve a serve at identity infact near impossible, as their physiological safety, love



and belonging needs are not met. Their physiological needs are not met as they don't have sheller, clear blotting, adequate food etc. Their safety needs are not met as they don't have tore a secure have environment. They have difficulty meeting love and pelonging needs as they don't stay in the one place long enough to form sustainable relationship, A breakdown in family relationships is often the reason homeloes people left home in the first place. Homeless people connat find a serve of identity without employment, hensing, and a family a friend relationship. These are very difficult to achieve in this situation

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O The Afex nove difficulty recording equity The timeless have difficulty receiving equity in society as they don't have fair chance for employment. This is because they have no home for them to shave in, they can ofter not afferd preventable attive, and have no permenent address. They also experience difficulty in receiving equity in other aveas such as centre inte payments and medicare cards as they have no permanent adobers. They can also not access health care equally to other as they can't afford it, and cannot receive a healthcare and or a medicare card. The government is addressing these equity issues through initiatives such as supported Accomodation Program (SATE Assistance Program (SAAP) and Corsis Accomodation Program (CAP) Both these programs are government funded. SHAP provides funding to organisations providing services for homeless people, while CAP provides purdage for buying and mantaining properties for hondess.

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These two programs support the separtment of Housing to provide delter for homeless people. However, there is not sufficient public harsing and the wouting lists are long. This housing is also after of poor quality, and crisis acconsodation is only temporary. This means that when a family can no longer stay in crisis accommodation, they have nowhere eld to go. Health issues for the homeless are also being addressed by the gavennest of NSW Health serds nurses out on the sweets to provide medical care. While this helps the problem it has not uned it. There is not adequate health care for the specific needs of homeless regile. These needs the include, treatment for depression, alcohol and substance abuse conselling. The government attempts to provide prancial support for homeless people by & doug their best to give them acces to centerlink persing but with no home address this is very

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The age have less ability to socialise. Over half of people 6541 and over still write at home require some form of government support. The Aged are often unable to work and this means they have less mane to satisfy their needs, leading to reduced equity. The conconnect is addressing these equily issues through many mitiatives. These include Home and the community lave. This is a program which provides funding for services helping the aged to remain at home longer. This is an initiative by the government implemented to compart the problem of an aging population and not sufficient nevery homes to accomposite them. Centreline provides a payment of \$386.90 per fortnight to single aged people. The Cont. also publishes a paughlet called "what's age got to do with it. This helps the aged to have what services are available to them
