

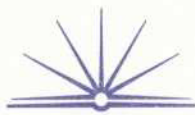

⑩ We have studied about special places which you can go or call to help you out about being a <sup>better</sup> ~~parent~~ parent and carer. there are many places that can help you out with being a

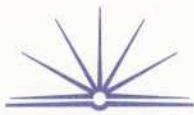


parent or a carer.
