on a low income whether they work or not. There are many places like refuges which help out and make you feel safe & secure.

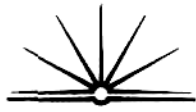
The Aged group depending on their health may still live in their family home but if they are not they need a safe environment like a hostel.
