Composers of Composers was texts to explore and convey to their responders concepts of changing perspectives. Some such texts are "Looking for otherandi" by Melina Marchetta, "Sky-high" by Hannah Roberts and Estate "Never Been Kissed" produced by Sandy Isaac and Nancy Vionen.

In the text "Looking for Alibrand," by Melina Marchetta, the composer has used the short sentence "I don't want her" that emphasises the character Michael Andreth's strong view on Josephine. Later the composer uses repetition of the character Michael Andretti's view to emphasise the change in his perspective of his daughter Jose Josephine. This is made apparent

The composer has united this short story with a nastalgictone to convey to the responder the once little girl's longing to have the freedom that she had when she was young. By the composer using the metaphor "feeling as facily and nearly as pink as the bathows I am wearing" it helps show the responder the feeling of freedom that this young girl has. This sentence shows the restraint by the adulthood that the girl now feels and shows the responder the impulsiveness and the freedom of the girl had now gone with adult responsibilities.
