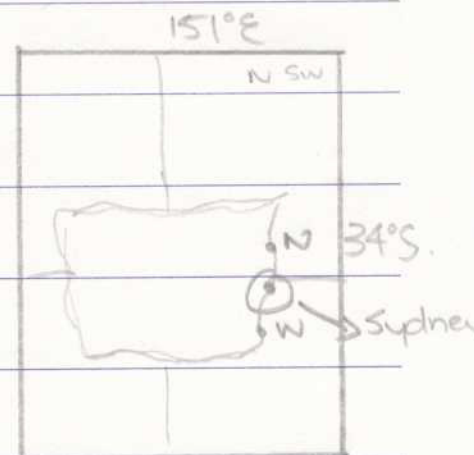
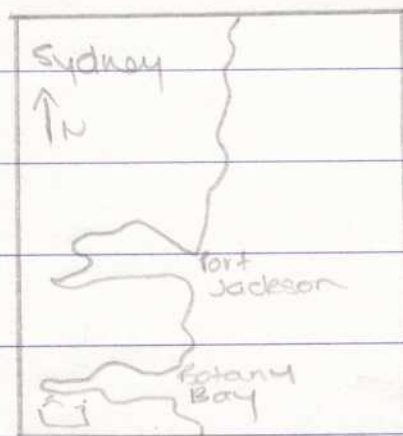
The World City is identified as having financial stability and being able to cater for the population that it holds.

Mega City is identified through the amount of people it holds. Mega city has more than 8 million people residing it.

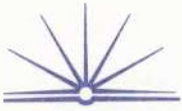
It is possible to have a world city and also be a mega city.

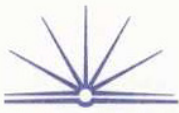
urban dynamic results included:
