- (a) Using Sources A and B, calculate the percentage of Brazil's population living in Sao Paulo in the year 2000. 1

$17\,800\,000 \div 165\,405\,000 \times 100 =$
 10.76% of Brazil's population lives in Sao Paulo

- (b) Using Source A, identify TWO features of the population pyramid that make it typical of a mega city in the developing world. 2

The first feature is that there are a lot ~~more~~ of younger people, making up roughly 2 thirds of the population and secondly there is an even distribution of males and females.

- (c) Describe ONE health issue and ONE social issue that a mega city in the developing world could face in the next decade. 4
