Question 19 (7 marks)

- (a) Using Source I, describe the spatial pattern of the global production of oil in 2000. 3

The majority ($\frac{2}{3}$) of the oil produced in the world comes from the Middle East. Central South America, Africa, and Eastern Europe & the former USSR together ~~make~~ produce $\approx \frac{1}{4}$ of the world's oil. The rest of the world either produces no oil or contributes to the final 10%.

- (b) Describe TWO factors influencing the future direction of a global economic activity you have studied. 4

Aquaculture - two factors which influence the ^{future} direction of world aquaculture are: ① the demand for seafood globally and ② the availability of naturally grown (wild, as opposed to manmade aquaculture) seafood which is usually cheaper.
