(D ii) In 1947, Albert Speer was appointed Minister for Armaments and War Production. He contributed in Manyways toward the Nazi war effort. Speer in creased production of munitions by 300% by reducing waste and convincing Hitler to let women into the work force. Speer also funded testing of rockets, which Hitler was pleased by, and. ordered mass production. Speer, hower, thought they needed to be advanced further to be effective, as the Allied weaponry was much Forther advanced then their own. Spear also scaled down the use of slave labour, as he saw it that it provided

poor results. Finally, Speer changed Hitlers mind on his scorched earth policy. Hitler intended to durate burn all things that could be of use to the rapidly advancing energy. Speer convinced him that if would be better just to cripple the factornes, as if Germany won the war they would be needed.
