

(ii) speen played a major role in the wari war effort, and was hugely successful as minister for armaments and munitions.

After many architectural commissions until 1941, speen was promoted to minister of armaments and munitions an 8 February 1942. Before speer came to pomer, the situation of war production, was ineffective This was due to the former minister Fritz Tools, who was unable to produce the uncreasing capacity of armaments and munitions recessary for the



war effort. On much powt, this was result of the representatives of the Armed Forces, who had an implicit prejudice to moss production. As a result, \$ Toat's meapons were custom made and superior, but the system was very the ineffective.

As soon as speer come to power, he focused solely on impraring the war production. Speen was extremely successful, an increased numbers of many armaments. For example the number of combat aircraft rose from 11,000 in 1942 to 38,000 by 1948, to counter bombings from the enemy. The number of tourks produced increased from 2,800 in 1902 to 17,300 by 1944,1 and speer produced six-times the the amount of ammunition than Toolt had. Speer check cheated enough equipment to support 225 infantry divisions, and there were only 150. Hitler was so unipressed by speer's success that, in July



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1943, promoted him to " Reich Minister for
Armaments and war Production"-marking
speer the second most powerful morn
in Ciermany.
Speen was so successful become he immediately
focused on increasing production. Speer initially
only had a workforce OF 2.7 million, but
through the use of Germans and imported
slave labour, increased this to immillion
by 1944.
speer was also so achieving because he built
up around himself a very efficient system
to oversee at the industry. Where Took had
had 3 main committies, Speer had 13. At any
one time there were 40 key chairmen who
would report personally to speer, allowing =
him to intervene at immediately if
necessony.
