In 1941 Albert Speer because involved in the Nazi war effect with the title of "minister for armaments and munitions". In 1942 however, his power greatly increased with his tile being expanded to "minister for armaments and war-production" With this power come responsibility for the production of factories and Tabour. Under Speers control production of equipment for the bernen wer effort warrased significantly to the poil that speer hunself betieved that if it had not been for him the war would have been lost 14 1992-43. However, this increase of production came at a great human cost. Spear though was soldy concerned with the ways in which he could produce more and ranely did he grestion the circumstances that the slave labourers were forced to most in. There were tails of Lindness on Specie

behalf, because he did recognise that for production to effectively occur workers must be my resonable environment. These acts of hiludress though were none and more often then not labours experience exerceiatingly paintal conditions. The Dora plan is an example of such cryety. A system of underground Packbories that produced artillery, these tactories had poor ventilation, sandtation and workers were literally worked to Many of the workers in Speers Gactories had been imported from other countries. It was illegal to have workers in factories that were producting weapons that may be used against their own country, but Nevertheless Speer continued to use such workers While production under his controll Increased significantly, Speer claimed

to be unaware of Hither's final solution, the holocaust. Serving Hitler with unwavening support it seems untikely that speer had no knowledge of the externition of Jews occurring i'u concentration most gamps. Many historians now believe that not only was speen aware of the final solution but an active contributer. Speer himself however claims to have never questioned the tradtuent of Jews and that news nothing of it. Speer however is believed to have been present at the Posen Meeting where Hitler's Intentions of eradicating the Jews was expressed. Speer has also been seen as contributile to the final solution due to the harsh treatment of Jews in his factories. In 1945 though Speer maintained his knocente in the Final solution, however,
