The Tet offensive in 1968 areas has proven to be a very effective teather used by the North Vietnamene frmy and the Viet Minh. The Tet effensive was a surprise attack on the South and us soldiers. Although the North had asked to cease fire during the new year and Christmas, on the New Year festival day of Tet, The North struck the South. The US officials believed that the North were going to Plan
