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- a) i) One benefit of drug testing is that it evens out the playing field in sports events so that those who are cheating are punished. However one limitation is that testing is random. So while some people get caught others are missed. Drug testing doesn't necessarily mean everyone is caught.
- ii) Performance enhancing drugs are considered unethical in sport for a variety of reasons. Firstly they are unhealthy for the body and can carry a range of bad health consequences. As well as this it portrays sport in a negative light. People will turn away from watching and participating sport if there is not an even playing field. Performance enhancing drugs are also unethical because not all athletes take them thus it is unfair for clean athletes as they are not awarded for their legitimate effort. Many children also look up to athletes as role models. Therefore if they see that their idols are

taking drugs they may feel that it is okay to take drugs in sport. And finally sponsorship deals rely on athletes to promote their products, if athletes are therefore caught taking drugs people could stop buying that product which impacts negatively on the sponsorship company.

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
