Question 18

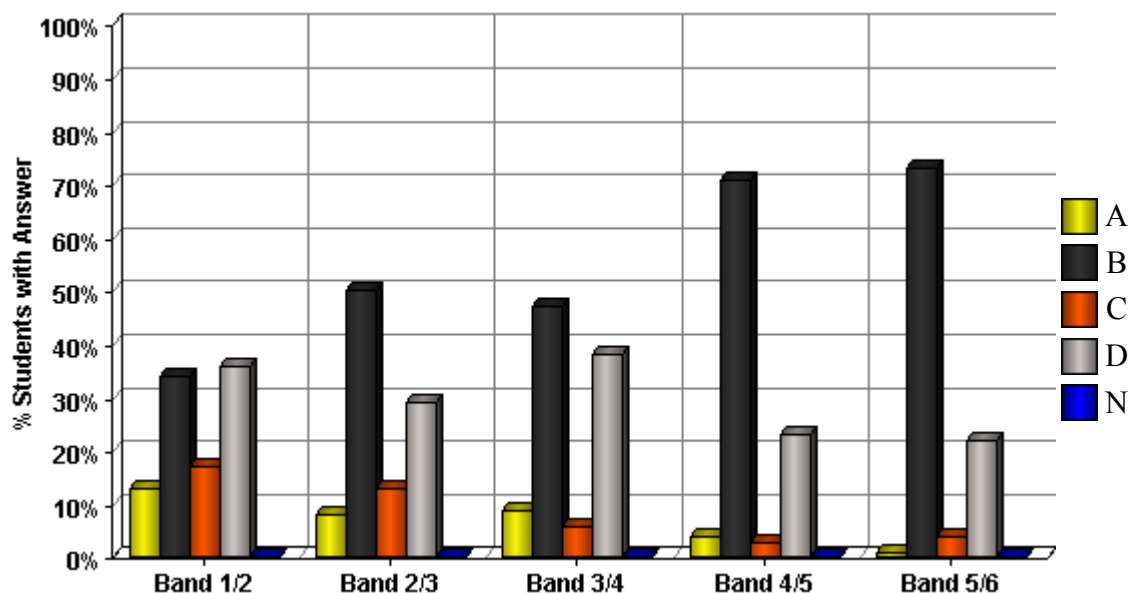
