

Pape John XXIII was significant to

reforms. Pope John XXIII Started a canal
called vaticas 11 which was an correct

christianity, he did this in various
ways such as depleting the confession
box, nuns to uniforms were changed, and
most significantly, he made mass allowed
masses and liturgies to be spoken in
the language of the people which ever they
prevered instead of in Latin. John XXIII also
wrotes texts such as "mater et mastra"
which spake of social issues within the
christian church and also wrote "pacem in"
Temis" which was a test not only for
christians but for "all men of Good Will".
He also pushed for peace in the world,
in one occasion in the Cubian Missire
