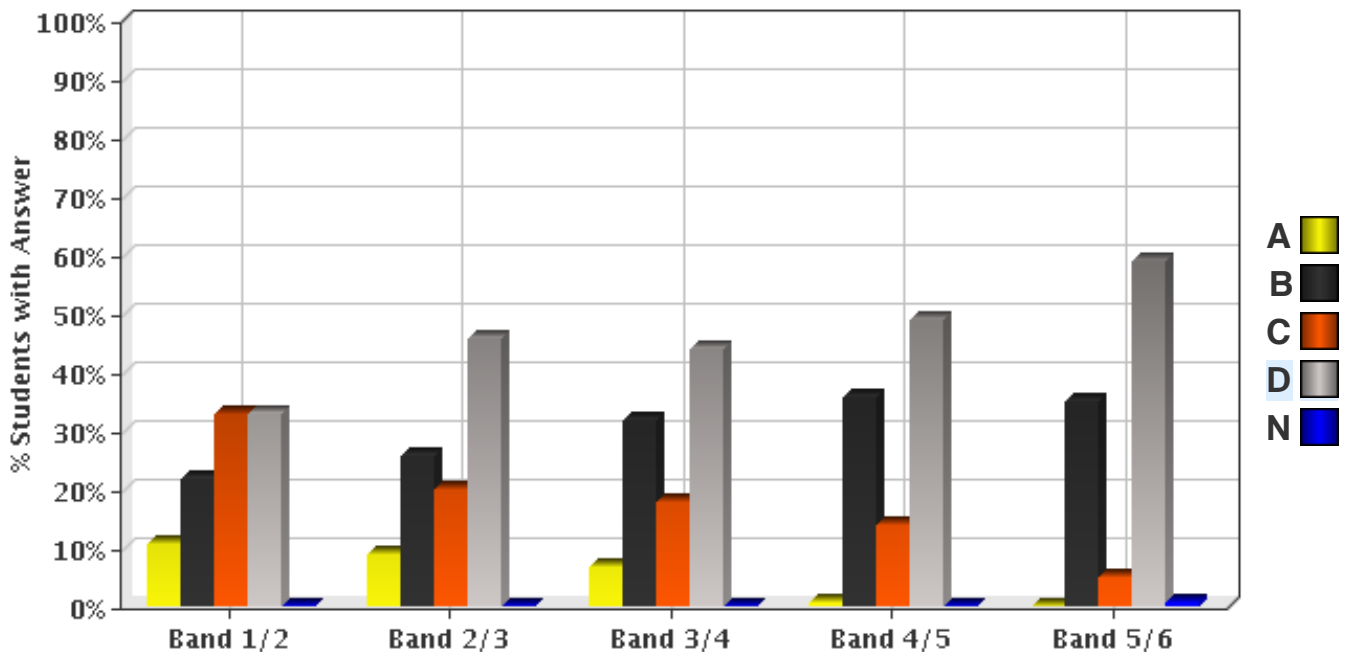


## Question 19
