Other signs and symbols consist a mother grieving over her dead child reflecting humand suffering. A soldier clutches to a small flower, as death approaches showing defiant apposition. The Spanish people are depicted as a borse reening in pain and townend. As well as signs and symbols other techniques of the autwork help to convey message. The large scale of the artwork, approximasely 3x7 meses helps to heighten the emotional impact
