9) Robert Rouschenberg's relationship with his art work can be seen on many different levels in Plake's 172. He takes a hands on opproach as he silk screens in plake 1 indicating that he likes to be involved in his works at a deep level. The works around him in Plate 1 suggest a personal relationship with his work, he is surrounded by it, it inturn effected by it. All of the works in both place 232 depict similar images, suggesting a strong involvment with the subject of his art with this reoccuring montif, it would appear that the ideals expressed are of great importance to him to be has a very deep relationship with his work. Rauschenberg obviously holds his vork very highly t endeavours to make it just right as shown in plake 4. very highly

ARD DF STEDIES with this in mind it can also be seen that he has a personal relationship with his work.
