Jackson pollock is an example of an ortist who is affected mainly physically by the aspect of time. Lin Onus is a well-known Aboriginal ortist that was boin in 1975. He was influenced by his father at a young age as to telped in the family souvinear stop. Drus was affected deepty by the conflicts that crosse between indigenous and white Australia. So Herefore began Creating ortworks that focused mainly on reconciliation: his view of all cultures living together and practicing their own cultures and traditions in peace. It was the visine of

Hovever Onus was obsessed with inventing rew techniques to make his practice faster and more advanced. He was not afraid of Jechnology and included many time-saving devices in his practice. For example the use of dotting machines and ones more that the dotting machine to paint in croppings inder stencils. Morgan's tamous mork "Citizenship" shows a dog painted in striking black and white wearing tags around ils nock. These read in 1994 Abonginals were allowed to become



"Australian Citizens". In this work Morgan is representing the papers that they recieved for Citizenship, as dog tags. That the idea that they they need to corn this is Indicrous when they were always Australian. Morgan represents the aspect of time and how it took so many years for white Australia to accept indigenous people as citizens. Through morgans actual ort-making ste is not concerned with time. Ste is in no hurry. However her practice is effected as the Aborignal techniques such as dotting and "rarrk" (an exclusive cross-hatching nethod) take time, effort and patience Herotoire allowing her to get real feel and meaning into the works. Sally Morgan's concepts are effected by the concept of time, similar to Onue, Her actual ortimaking is a tedious détailed nork that talees nany



hows and plentare effects her prompanion. Morgan represents emotional concepts and Achiques which are effected by fine and as concepts and techniques are included was in practice, this artists about practice is therefore effected by thre Finally the artist Jackson Pollock is a gouten modern ortist, not concerned with concepts but uses his time and skill to creater artworks for the sake of artworks. pollock's no practice sees him laying convases on me floor and is seen to "dance around his carvas" applying paint in Impredictable and incontrollable fashion. Pollock's works relies on the mixtures of various colows and the application of techniques such as line and shapp. Therefore Pollock seems to work quickly. This artworks rely on quick-movement in order to develop the effect he desires. Pollock applies point.



and uses objects such as sticles and his hands, swirls, dabs and nixes paint to create his works. An example of an artwork Pollock has created under his technique at for arts sake is Cathedral" This is a large convas representing lives of colour, dominantly black and white representing nothing in particular.
