He used his works to the appeal to people to use a condom whilst having sex. It's interesting to nate that most his works were installed in 'everyday' places, (such as the railway station, sides of houses), thus being accessable to 'everyday' people whom the values he was preaching were more applicable. His subjective works were heavily influenced by his own life. His arti-AIDS works most promininantly because he himself was a victim of this ghastly disease. Whitst Having appealed to Barbara kruger is another artist that
