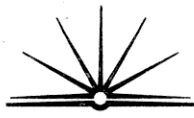


Question one

of Etruria, the enemy grows

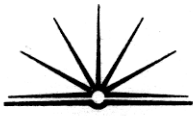


in number every single

destruction for the republic.

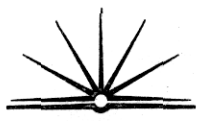


(b) But if from so great a

~~will seem to be~~

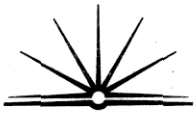
we will perhaps seem
