

bi. Cicero might expect to experience "invidiam" if he orders Catiline to go into exile because Cicero, as of now, has not convinced everyone that Catiline is a public enemy who should be exiled. To condemn him now would probably lead to public backlash and ruin his reputation.

ii. The derogatory portrayal of Catiline's character reveals to the audience the dark side of Catiline and in turn contributes to an attack on Catiline.

By showing Catiline to be a most foul man in lines like:

"dum modo ista sit privata calamitas"

and by making comments about the republic in regards to ~~the~~ the republic:

"rei publice periculis circumdatus"

we clearly see a bad side of Catiline which is contributing to the weakness in the republic.
