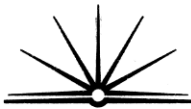
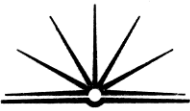

there (placed her foot there): The

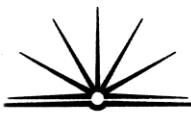
Greens had rushed in and were holding
