Question 16 (6 marks)

There are a number of chemicals and hazardous products used in the automotive industry.

What are the THREE ways that chemical/hazardous products can enter the human body? Explain in each case how you would protect yourself from this happening.

- (i) You can get ~~acid~~^{metal} in your eyes when you are using a grinder or anything like that which could blind you. In this case you should be wearing your safety goggles. 2
- (ii) Battery acid could leak out of a battery and onto your skin while you are replacing the battery. You should be wearing your gloves and overalls to prevent this from happening. 2
