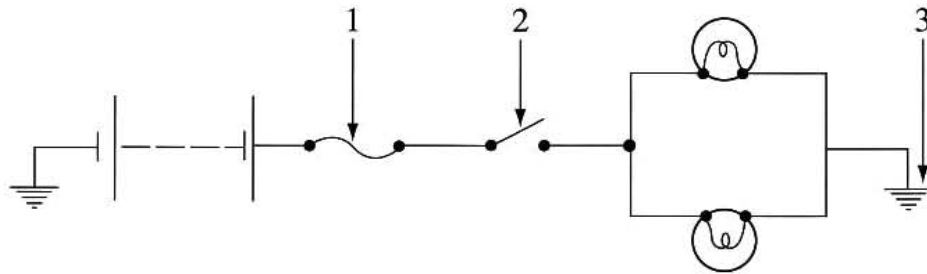

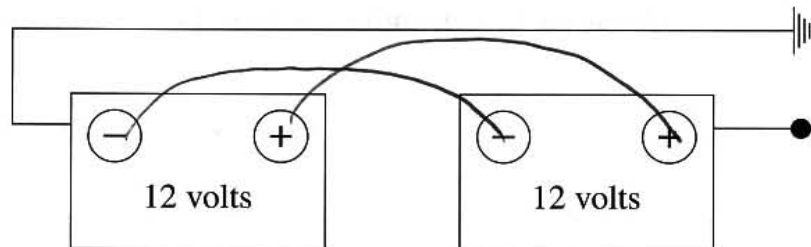


Complete the table naming and describing the function of each numbered component.

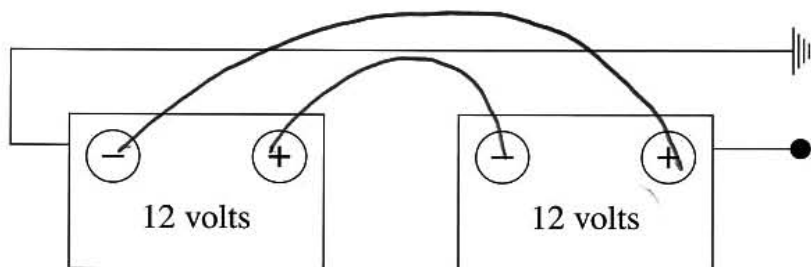
(d) In the diagram below, draw lines to show how to connect the terminals to increase battery output voltage to 24 volts.
