One example of this is the EPA (Environmental Protection Authority). The EPA is responsible for enforcing ALL environmental protection regulations across all industries. They are also responsible for making companies clean up after environmental accidents and for issuing fines if these accidents were caused by negligence.

The MVRIA (Motor vehicle repair industry Authority) is also responsible for upholding environmental standards across the automotive industry.
