repair problems. All of these workplaces must follow all rules set in order to remain accredited.

One of these issues is that of waste. Every day, hundreds of materials and parts are removed from vehicles due to a fault or a recommended upgrade. All workplaces must provide an environmentally friendly method to dispose of these items. One very popular method is material waste collection, performed by accredited professionals. These services collect any materials and then dispose of them in a way which is as environmentally friendly as possible.

Another waste issue is hazardous materials, or chemicals. Chemicals are necessary in the automotive workplace to function tools ~~and~~ and repair/run vehicles. The collection of these chemicals is similar to other waste collection. A licensed group will collect any

chemicals regularly from workplaces and either destroy or recycle them for other purposes. The workplace must have all these chemicals stored in a well ventilated, bonded area, and must pay for removal.

The last problem is noise. Mechanics workplaces are extremely noisy due to engines and tools, so noise is a big problem in residential areas. To remedy this, local councils can enforce a work time which all workplaces must abide by. This means that no tools and loud noise is to be commenced between certain hours, ie 5pm and 8am.

These are just three major environmental issues in the automotive workplace, all of which can be solved by compliance to rules and regulations.
